

Volunteer Role Description

Illustrator volunteer

GMFA's vision and mission statement:

Vision – GMFA wants a gay community where individuals are able to make informed choices about their health, and a society that embraces equality and respects the right of people to make informed choices.

Mission – Improving gay men's health by increasing the control they have over their own lives. experience of the gay community.

Role

To provide traditional illustrations (paintings, drawings, other non-electronic images) or designs for various GMFA projects / interventions.

Specific responsibilities

Creating illustrations for assigned GMFA projects, following agreed briefs.

Experience and Requirements

Illustrator volunteers must have relevant qualifications or experience.

Must submit a sample of work to GMFA.

Illustrators should have access to necessary tools.

Work productively with groups.

Commitment required

Illustrator volunteers should complete any illustrator brief as agreed and within any timeframe given.

Authority

Illustrator volunteers have the authority to make any decisions necessary to meet the brief. However ultimate authority for the final content will remain with the group developing the intervention.

Benefits

Illustrator volunteers have the potential to add to their portfolio of published work.

Achieve a high level of exposure for their work.

Potential to add to their experience as an illustrator.

Potential Frustrations

An illustrator's work may not be chosen for publication.

The illustration may require a number of amendments before the approval process is complete.

A range of skills & knowledge needed.

Illustrator volunteers only work periodically.

Potential Satisfactions

Working creatively to find design solutions that increase the impact of GMFA projects / interventions.
