



Volunteer Role Description

Photographer

GMFA's vision and mission statement:

Vision – GMFA wants a gay community where individuals are able to make informed choices about their health, and a society that embraces equality and respects the right of people to make informed choices.

Mission – Improving gay men's health by increasing the control they have over their own lives.

Role

To implement the photographic elements of any assigned GMFA project / interventions.

Specific responsibilities

Generating the photographic element of GMFA projects assigned to, following the agreed design briefs.

Experience and Requirements

Photography volunteers must have either relevant qualifications or experience. Must submit examples of high quality photographic work they have created to GMFA.

Must have own professional standard camera equipment.

Must be able to work productively with design volunteers & groups.

Commitment required

Photography volunteers should complete any brief as agreed and within any timeframe given.

Authority

Photography volunteers have the authority to make any visual/photographic decisions necessary to meet the brief. However ultimate authority for the final content will remain with the volunteers & project manager developing the intervention.

Benefits

Photography volunteers have the potential to add to their portfolio of published work.

If used the work will achieve a high level of exposure.

Potential Frustrations

A photographer's work may not be chosen for publication.

Photography volunteers only work periodically.

Potential Satisfactions

Helping fulfil design briefs that increase the impact of GMFA projects / interventions.
